Hope Chapel

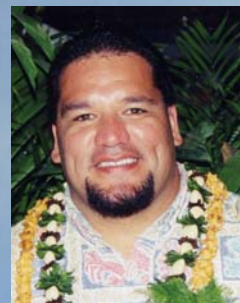
